Dear Parent/Carer,

On Monday 16 October Year 2 will be visiting Conisbrough Castle as part of our History topic. They will see features of a castle and be given background information to enable them to answer our enquiry question for this topic <u>Why did Monarchs need to build castles and why were they</u> <u>important?</u>

The children will be finding out more about the castle and Norman life and will also be taking part in a "Meet the Medievals" workshop run by the education staff at the castle. This will be an exciting and interesting day for the children and will provide them with a hands-on experience to support their learning in school. This visit will also be used as a base for other cross curricular lessons once back in school.
