Local Mosque and Doncaster Museum Visit - Year 5

As part of our Religious Education studies, we are going to visit the Mosque in Doncaster. It is a very important part of our curriculum as it develops our understanding of the world's religions and promotes mutual respect in our diverse society.

After lunch, we will also be visiting the Doncaster Museum, which has an art gallery and library inside it too. We will walk from the Mosque to the library as it is within walking distance.

This visit will be on Thursday 9th May 2024. We will be leaving school at 9:30am and will return to school by the end of the school day.

The cost for this trip is £8.50 per child which should be paid on Parent Pay.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch and a water bottle, and we will be eating at the Mosque. **Due to religious reasons, we have been asked that the children do not have anything in their lunch that contains any meat or strong-smelling foods. We are nut free due to allergies and this includes Nutella.** We will need to check all packed lunches before the visit.

They should wear their school uniform and please could we also ask that the children bring something to cover their heads with on the day of the visit, like a scarf or a cap/hat as a mark of respect and tradition.
