**Year 2 Trip to the National Emergency Services Museum.**

Dear Parent/Carer.

On Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> November Year 2 will be visiting the National Emergency Services Museum in Sheffield as part of their 'The Great Fire of London' topic in History.

As well as exploring the museum, the children will take part in a workshop where they will travel back in time to 1666 when King Charles II was on the throne and a huge fire ravaged London. They will learn how the Great Fire was extinguished and the legacy it holds by handling real and replica objects, dress up as a soldier fighting the fire and try some of the methods they used. This will be an exciting and interesting day for the children and will provide them with a hands-on experience to support their learning in school.

The cost for this trip is £14.50 per child which should be paid on Parent Pay. Payment acts as consent that your child is allowed to attend.

The children should arrive at school at the normal time and will return for the end of the school day as normal. They should wear their school uniform with comfortable shoes and they will also require a packed lunch.
