Dear Parent/Carer,

On Friday 7th October Year 2 will be visiting Conisbrough Castle as part of our History topic. They will see features of a castle and be given background information to enable them to answer our enquiry question for this topic Why did Monarchs need to build castles and why were they important?

The children will be finding out more about the castle and Norman life and will also be taking part in a "Meet the Medievals" workshop run by the education staff at the castle. This will be an exciting and interesting day for the children and will provide them with a hands-on experience to support their learning in school. This visit will also be used as a base for other cross curricular lessons once back in school.

The cost for this trip is £10.50 per child which should be paid on Parent Pay. The children should arrive at school at the normal time and we will return for the end of the school day as normal. This is a voluntary contribution however if insufficient funds are received we will not be able to run this visit. Children should wear their school uniform and ensure they have a waterproof coat with them. They will also require a packed lunch.
