Easter Foodbank Appeal

Dear Parents and Carers,

As we approach the Easter period, our school would like to support our local community by taking part in the Easter Foodbank Appeal. We will be collecting donations to support the wonderful work of Doncaster Foodbank, who provide emergency food parcels to families experiencing hardship.

At this time of year, foodbanks continue to see very high numbers of local people needing support. Services are under increasing pressure and additional donations are needed to ensure that everyone who needs help can receive essential food supplies.

Last year during the six weeks of Lent, Doncaster Foodbank provided 541 food vouchers, helping 949 people, including 238 children. Similar demand is expected again this year.

We would be very grateful if families who are able to donate could bring in any of the following items:

- Long life milk
- Long life fruit juice
- Tinned tomatoes
- Tinned meat or fish
- Tinned fruit
- Tinned vegetables
- Tinned beans or spaghetti
- Cooking sauces
- Cereals
- Tinned puddings

If you would like to contribute, **please send donations into school with your child on Wednesday 25th March 2026**. We will have a collection point in school and will ensure all items are delivered to the foodbank. Please remember that we are a nut-free school, so kindly ensure that no items containing nuts are included.
