Dear Parents and Carers,

Your child's end of year report will be sent home today and I'm certain you will be proud of the many ways your child has progressed and developed this year.

As well as comments from teachers and myself, the reports contain the following information:

- The **attainment grade** is based on government expectations of what children should be able to do for their age at this time of year.
- The **attitude to learning** grade is based on how well your child applies themselves in class and in all aspects of school life. We encourage children to do their best, show our ASPIRE Values and Learning Superpowers (Resilience, Evaluation, Collaboration and Investigation).
- If your child took part in a **statutory test** (i.e. Phonics check or SATs), you will also receive a summary of their results and a comparison to the national average. I'm delighted to tell you that in all areas across the school, we have achieved outcomes that are significantly above the national average, this shows how effective our teachers are and curriculum is. Our Key Stage 2 SATs results are the best our school has ever had!
- The **attendance figures** on the report are up to the end of the last half term. We've also included their attendance certificate which provides you with details of all attendance and absence this year.
