### **Year 3 Trip to Murton Park**

Year 3 will be visiting Murton Park in York. The visit will be a living history day based upon life in that period. Children will get the chance to experience what it was like to live in a Stone Age settlement and learn about the dawn of farming.

In order for this visit to go ahead, we require a voluntary contribution from each child of £36, payable on our Parent Pay system. This can be paid in one lump sum or as three payments through the summer if that helps.

The charge is made up of £18 for the coach and £18 for entry to the museum.

This includes the provision of a dedicated historian who will guide us through a day of interactive activities which are not available to the general public. Throughout the day, we will be dressed in costume (provided by the site) and having sole use of the replica village. It is important that we receive a maximum number of contributions; otherwise the visit is unlikely to go ahead. This promises to be a fantastic day, with many hands-on activities which will inform follow up work and reinforce work already covered. **Children will not require any spending money.**
