The Deep Visit – Year 4

Dear Parents and Carers.

During the summer term, we are learning about 'Our Oceans'. As an engaging introduction to this topic, we are visiting **The Deep** and will be learning about different sea creatures and food chains, and taking part in the 'Our World Plastic Problems' workshop. This workshop will link to our Science and Geography work in school by looking at how our oceans and the animals that live there are being affected by plastic and ways in which we can reduce our plastic footprint.

The visit will take place on Tuesday 2nd June 2026. We need to leave school at 9am so please ensure that your child arrives at school promptly.

A voluntary contribution of £21.00 is payable via Parent Pay. (This is for the cost of the coach and entrance per child). Payment also acts as consent that you are happy for your child to attend. **If we don't get sufficient contributions, we will be unable to run the visit.**

The Children will need to come to school in their full school uniform.

They will also require a packed lunch including a drink (no cans of fizzy drinks, and please remember that we are nut free and this includes Nutella). Any child who normally receives a school meal can be provided with a packed lunch if required. (Please request this from the school office by Friday 15th May with their full name, and choice of ham, cheese or tuna).
