**Writing Outcomes** 

**Letter** (Informal) - children write as an evacuee writing home

Narrative (Historical) - writing a spy story based on 'Noor-Un-Nissa Inayat Khan'

**Poem** – World War II as part of Remembrance Day celebrations

**Biography** – of Lewis Latimer, science link

Non-chronological report – tourist guide, linked to Heritage and Community topic

**Report** (Non-chronological) - report about biomes of the world based on 'The Incredible Ecosystem of Planet Earth'

**Persuasive speech** - encouraging people to reduce the amount of plastic they use.

**Narrative** - write an adventure story about a strange experience, based on 'Island'

**Narrative** – writing own Greek myths based on real ones

**Explanation** – create a double page spread explaining how the heart works, science link
