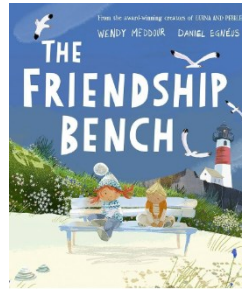


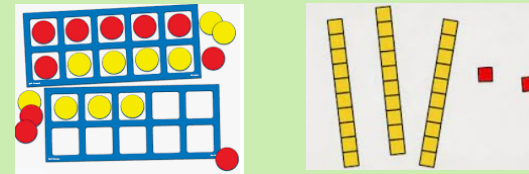
**English**

In **reading** we will be learning about the three different ways we can read to self (read the words, look at the pictures and re-tell the story). Once we have practiced these we will be looking to build our reading stamina and thinking about book choices. Each week we will fill our book boxes with 3 books that we would like to read.

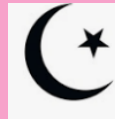


In **writing** we will start the year by recapping our Year 1 learning by focussing on what we need to include in our sentences e.g. capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. We will then move on to writing simple sentences to order and retell a story.

**Maths.** This half term our topic is place value. During this topic we will be learning that a two digit number is made up of tens and ones. We will learn how to represent these in lots of different ways using concrete resources such as dienes, numicon and tens frames. We will also compare numbers using 'greater than', 'less than' and 'equal to' as well as learning to count in steps of 2, 5 and 10.



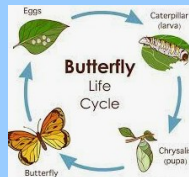
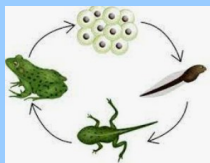
**In Religious Education, (RE)** This half term we are learning about Islam. We will learn about the Muslim beliefs, places of worship and the festival of Ramadan.



**In Personal Social, Health and Citizenship (PSHCE)**

This half term our topic is 'being me in my world' where we will learn about our rights and responsibilities as members of Year 2 and about making good choices.

**In Science** This half term our topic is Animals including Humans and we will be looking at how living things can stay healthy. We will learn that not all offspring look like their parents and about the different stages of growth in animals and humans. We will learn the life cycle of a frog, butterfly and human.

**In Foundation Subjects** This term in history we will be learning about Conisbrough Castle.
