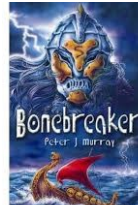


## English

Our **Core Texts** are: Bonebreaker and Attack of the Vikings. Our class reading books are There's a Viking in my Bed and The Last Firefox

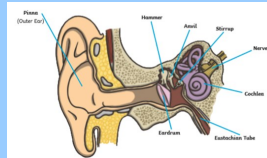


In **reading** we will explore new words, develop our fluency and learn how to answer questions about what we have read.

In **writing** we will write a set of instructions on how to be a fantastic pupil in Year 4. In this piece of writing, we will be focusing on using a range of adverbs (E.g. afterwards/ again/ beforehand), using question marks and exclamation marks and commas in a list. We will also be writing an informal letter to the children in Year 3. Here we will focus on the use of fronted adverbials (E.g. Interestingly/ In the distance/ Yesterday).

**In Religious Education, (RE)** This half term we will make links between some of Jesus' teachings like forgiving people.

**In Science** This half term we are learning to be audiologists as we will be studying sound and all of its properties. We will learn how sound is made and how we hear.

**Maths** This half term we are learning about statistics and place value, including how to; represent and partition numbers, round numbers and place numbers on a number line. We will also learn Roman Numerals.

We will also learn how to add and subtract two numbers with up to 4 digits, using efficient written methods. (E.g.  $3456 + 2749 =$  and  $8362 - 6186 =$ )

## In Personal Social , Health and Citizenship (PSHCE)

This half term we are learning about being part of a team and how democracy works.



**History** This half term we are learning about the Anglo Saxons and the Vikings, thinking about how they have shaped British history.

## Foundation Subjects

**In Art** we will be; comparing work by different artists; (Georgia O'Keeffe and Matthew Fisher) learning how to mix colours and adding detail to our paintings to make them look realistic.

**In PE** we will be learning how to play Basketball, including a variety of ball skills and attacking and defending techniques. We will also complete health and fitness activities.

**In Music** we will be learning how to play the Ukulele.

**In Computing** we will be learning about computing systems and networks, including how information is shared on the internet.

**In Spanish** we will learn how to present information about ourselves, including how to say our name, age and where we live in Spanish.
